



The Texas band's song about surviving a failed love "is for all the people who wish they could get over somebody by just deleting them from their brain," says lead singer Josh Abbott. "It's an extreme concept." It's also a tune that's rooted in a stretch of tough reality. "I actually wrote it two months before my ex-wife and I split," says Abbott. "I felt like the writing was a little on the wall." By the time the band set out to record the song, Abbott was officially divorced. "The song took on its own life because of the situation I had gone through," he says. "We experimented with its dark tone, and I think it turned out rad."
