Tim and Demi-Leigh Tebow chat with Us about the bond that keeps their relationship solid — and what's next

After four years of marriage, life is still an adventure for Tim Tebow and his wife, former Miss Universe Demi-Leigh Tebow, 29. "We travel a good amount," says the former Denver Broncos QB, 36, explaining that ministry and philanthropic work (the pair aid in the fight against human trafficking and in the support for people with special needs) has taken them around the globe. "We've already gotten to 11 countries so far this year. Next week will be our 12th," he adds. "It's really special to see the world together." special needs. [She] was kind of our matchmaker. We had something called Night to Shine, [which is] a worldwide celebration for people with special needs. Demi and her family were invited, but unfortunately her sister was too sick to go. But through that, we connected and never stopped talking.

Was philanthropy something that you two bonded over early in your relationship?

TT We'd probably call it purpose and calling. I don't know if she was inspired by me, but I was inspired by her.

Demi, were you a fan of Tim's before

meeting him?

DT I'm from South Africa, we don't have football or baseball. We watch rugby and cricket!

What's been the biggest challenge in your relationship?

DT Honestly, maybe the language barrier at the beginning. Loving in a second language is different. Remember the first time after our first date, I told you "keep well," and you thought I was dismissing you?

TT Yeah, that's true. Her first language is Afrikaans, not En-

glish. I was like, "keep well"? I was like, "I don't know if I'm going to see you again!"

Demi, was Tim supportive as you were writing A Crown That Lasts [due out Aug. 14]?

DT I'm so grateful [I had] a sounding board. There [were] nights of writing from 7 P.M. to like three in the morning. He'd just [make] me a hot bath with some Epsom salt.

TT I'm so excited about it. [It took] so much courage to write about the hard moments in her life. I think it's going to be a great encouragement... [to other] women.
